The Student Nutrition Program of Central East Ontario, administered by the Peterborough Family Resource Centre, works to ensure all children in the region attend school well nourished and ready to learn. We work to provide safe environments in which children and youth can develop healthy eating habits that will last a lifetime. Our programs take a universal approach, and serve all children in the region regardless of socioeconomic status. There are now more than 750 nutrition programs serving students in the City of Kawartha Lakes, the Counties of Haliburton, Northumberland, Peterborough, and Simcoe and the Regions of Durham and York.

We are currently seeking the services of an independent contractor to provide part-time community development services related to the coordination and support of 15-30 student nutrition programs in **York Region**, as well as work collaboratively with **York Region Food for Learning** (the Community Partnership Committee for the Region). This is a one-year contract with the possibility of renewal. The Student Nutrition Program is funded by Ontario's Ministry of Children and Youth Services and administered by the Peterborough Family Resource Centre.
